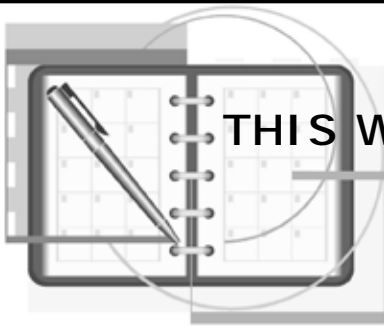
WELCOME MINISTRY
